Only a blank pistol incapable of firing live ammunition may be used. Horseback handling will be permitted in all stakes. THE AMERICAN POINTER CLUB

Invites you to the National Championship and companion events. This trial will be run at historic Fort Robinson State Park, in northwestern Nebraska. The courses are located along Soldier Creek, which is a live creek that is located among the 20,000+ acres of the park. The facilities are close and comfortable. There is lodging available in the park within walking distance of the starting line. **Lodging facilities are restored to a historic representation of the original fort with some modern conveniences. They are clean and comfortable. No TV or phone in rooms (cell phones work fine and pay phones are on the grounds).**

Reservations: When you make a reservation be sure to mention you are with the field trial club, especially for horse stalls. You want to keep horses in the “Mare Barn” as it is closest to the starting line. 308-665-2900

Park Fee \$2.50 per day or a yearly pass \$14.00

Most services require a reservation; prices do not include reservation fees.

CAMPING: Primitive area \$9.00 per night: Modern area with electric hookup \$13.00. Lavatory facilities and pay showers are available

LODGING SEASON: Early April – late November

RESERVATIONS: By phone or in person during park office hours 308-665-2900

CABINS/ADOBES: Sleeps 6, \$80/nt—Sleeps 8, \$90/nt—Sleeps 10, \$100/nt—Sleeps 12, \$110/nt –

BANDMASTERS QUARTERS: two bedrooms, \$90/nt

LODGE ROOMS: Double bed, \$35/nt – 2 twin beds, \$40/nt

BRICK HOUSES Sleeps 14, \$160/nt – Sleeps 18, \$180/nt-- Sleeps 20, \$200/nt

EXTRA BEDS Rollaway or crib, \$7 each

HORSE STALLS: \$10.00 per night plus a \$2.00 reservation fee (you clean). You may *NOT* stake out, use electric corrals, or tie your horse to the trailer. To keep your horse on the grounds you *MUST* rent a stall. Sorry, no exceptions!

WATER: Drinking and stock water is available and close.

FOOD: Lunch will be available from the park service with advance orders and payment. Nightly dinner plans to be announced. Provided either on the grounds by park food service or held at local restaurants.

RESERVATIONS ARE A MUST. Sign-up sheets for meals will be available in advance of the start of the Nationals.

ATTENTION ALL FIELD TRIAL PARTICIPANTS

Bring the family. You don't have to get up at dawn here. The rooms are within walking distance of the field trial area. There are fishing lakes, jeep rides (\$7.00/\$5.00 child), and horse drawn tours (\$4.00/\$2.50 child) available. The park is actually closed this time of year so in order to schedule tours, we must know, in advance, of your interest in any tours or rides. Please contact Jack Haines if you would like to participate if we schedule any tours. There are also self-guided tours of the historic area. Please remember we are guests of Fort Robinson State Park. This property must be kept clean. Please clean-up after your dogs and fill any holes created by dogs or horses. We have been asked to stake out dogs for a reasonable amount of time only. Please make every effort to preserve the natural environment, including vegetation, soil, water and wildlife.
